Eye Marker Systems, Inc. and West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection enter into Memorandum of Understanding

Morgantown, W. Va., February 8, 2007 – Eye Marker Systems, Inc. has entered into a partnership with The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (WVDEP). The purpose of the collaboration is to allow WVDEP to be able to rapidly assess exposure to organophosphates and other neurotoxins in WV residents that have been near or in the area of a release of those types of toxins.

Eye Marker Systems, Inc. has been committed to the research, discovery and commercialization of an innovative ocular screening technology since its founding in 2001. They developed the Eye Marker Platform and specialize in the development of image analysis software for the Ocular Scanning Instrument (OSI). The OSI is a unique, noninvasive device designed to examine and measure specific physical anomalies (biomarkers) in the eye and extrapolate these findings to evaluate the potential health impact to the entire body. The instrument also assists in giving the medical community the ability to recognize diabetes, hypertension and other systemic diseases through the human eye.

WVDEP has been dedicated to their mission of promoting, protecting and restoring a healthy environment through use of available resources since 1992. They operate and regulate according to environmental laws adopted by the United States Congress and the West Virginia Legislature. Through their implementation of programs controlling surface and groundwater pollution as well as oversight of construction, operation and closure of hazardous, solid waste and underground sites, WVDEP seeks an efficient and effective balance between natural resources, businesses and residents of the state.

The joint collaboration may include operational performance assessment and screening validation of the OSI prototype system for accidental exposure to organophosphate agents. The alignment of the two entities will produce mutual opportunities to participate

in the developmental guidance and feedback on the operational suitability and competency of prototypes.
